- ★ Promote innovation and resource efficiencies

- ★ Show promise for becoming a model program for replication on and off campus.

All Student Affairs employees and departments are eligible to participate. Please provide the following: (No more than 500 words, double spaced)

- ★ a concise, comprehensive description of the project
- ★ staff and departments committed to the project
- ★ budget proposal

The Student Affairs Innovation Projects Committee, established by the Vice Chancellor, will review the proposals, and may make suggestions as appropriate for further proposal development. The committee will forward its recommendations to the Vice Chancellor for final approval. Funding will be for the 2007-2008 year. Submit your project proposals to:
