Subject: Student Boards

Dear Students,

Want to make a change and leave your mark here on campus? Join one of the many Student Boards that influence decisions made around campus. Currently there are 4 major boards that students can get involved with.

1. Student Center Board. As the new student center develops and expands, the board will discuss what new things will be in the Student Center and any issues or concerns students may have with the Student Center.
2. Anteater Recreation Center Board (ARC Board). The ARC Board brings up student concerns in the ARC. The ARC will be expanding and the board will be making decisions on what new things will be at the ARC.
3. Bren Events Center Board. The Bren Events Center has a student advisory board which helps make the Bren better and more accessible to students and student groups. The board focuses on what is going on in the Bren and what new things can be done to make the Bren better for students.
4. Student Fee Advisory Committee (SFAC). This group deals mainly with your registration fee and advises the Executive Vice Chancellor on where new student fees should go. This committee allocates money to different student services and they make decisions on what services need more funding or enhancements.
